Malbec, 13.5%.

From low-yielding Malbec vines aged 70-80 years in Colchagua Valley,

this has fine, silky tannins and enticing red fruit with a very long finish. Matured in 20% new oak, with the rest in concrete eggs and oak foudres. Oenologist Nicolas Perez defied difficult conditions, picking before the rain came in mid-April. Excellent quality.
